Professional Development - *The Professional Development Committee is a district committee which is comprised of individual building representatives that oversee the recertification and professional development tracking program otherwise known as My Learning Plan (MLP). The committee meets on a monthly basis and is overseen by the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment. The focus of the committee is to ensure that teachers and staff are utilizing the MLP tracking system according to district and state guidelines in an effort to document and record all professional development hours as required under each participant's certification(s). Hours are tracked according to content and/or district hours to fulfill the state mandated recertification process at the end of the three or five year cycle. Key topics that the committee discusses and reviews are in regard to changes in any policy or state mandates and how the hours for the various professional development activities are to be submitted into the MLP program for continuity, approval and accountability. The process is continuously reviewed to ensure compliance to the existing policies and to update the MLP program to eliminate redundancy and any inadequacies in the existing program format or usability. Courses, seminars and workshops are approved by the committee members and reviewed each month. In addition, building representatives provide continuous training at each building site to individual and small groups on an as needed basis. Meetings are generally on Tuesdays from 3:15 to 4:45pm*
